



Sport Towel: Wow, What a Towel! The nice thing about the Sport Towel is that it is super absorbent and it dries very quickly after you use it, so you always have a dry towel. It is also antibac...so the fact that it dries so fast and is antibac means you don't have a stinky, heavy towel to deal with while you are camping.
